The Crisis We Face. The American working class is being decimated by rising costs, stagnant wages, and a political system that serves the powerful, not the people.

For decades, we the people have built the wealth of this nation, while the profits earned from our labor have disproportionately been consolidated among the few at the top. The industries we sustained have been outsourced, automated, or dismantled. And the communities we call home have been drained of resources, jobs, and hope.
